COVID Protocols

Arrival

- Temperature checks and a Covid questionnaire will be administered on arrival.
- Rapid tests will be administered for all individuals without a vaccination card (\$10.00 fee).
- Masks will be worn upon entering the MAC Center.
- Only campers will be permitted in the MAC Center.
- Campers will be able to change in the Men's general locker room.
- Masks will be worn exiting the MAC Center on the way to WildCat Stadium.

Camp Activities

- Masks will be worn with the exception of on-field activity by players.
- Players will be expected to bring their own water bottles, towels, etc.
- All players participating will only use the WildCat Stadium restrooms throughout the day.
- Family members will only use the restrooms located in WildCat Stadium.

Post Camp

- Families in attendance will wait for campers outside in the MAC Center parking lot area for departure.

COVID PLEDGE

COVID-19 is a highly contagious infectious virus. The goal of the Randolph College Athletics Department is to minimize the risk of exposure and mitigate the effects of the virus within our camps. All campers must abide by this pledge to participate in camp activities.
